Description:

BANDIT is a very adaptable variety producing strong plants that yield well with a high percentage of first grade fruit. The plant has an open growing habit with early maturity and is suitable for warm season production (summer to early autumn) in southern areas, extending further in other regions. This variety has resistance to Target Spot and Scab with intermediate resistance to Powdery Mildew. The fruits are medium ribbed, dark green in colour with a consistent length of 33-36cm.
