PONIENTE is a high yielding European type providing excellent quality fruit with an extensive disease package which includes Gummosis, Powdery Mildew, and Cucumber Mosaic Virus. The open but well balanced plant has good vigour and power with progressive easy setting, and a low rate of flower abortion under warm conditions. The fruit are dark and straight with a nice tidy neck and moderately ribbed appearance, and average approx. 30-33cm length. PONIENTE is suggested for sowing in spring through to late summer, harvesting in late spring, summer and autumn in most areas.
