### Description:

TOMAGINO is an early maturing indeterminate truss cherry in the Conchita class for heated greenhouse. The glossy cherry size fruit average 20-22gm with round shape, attractive green calyx and good firmness, with very long shelf life and excellent flavour. The plant has good vigour, with moderately open habit and is medium long jointed in structure. TOMAGINO is early to mature with rapid truss development and very uniform truss formation.

**Cultural Notes:** The use of a rootstock is recommended with this variety as *Fusarium Wilt* resistance is limited to Fol:0. Additional cultural notes available on request.
