The indeterminate plant and fruit are of a good set and size and AMATI produces uniform and firm fruit on a fishbone truss. AMATI's average fruit weight is approx.150g and has high resistance to Fusarium Crown and Root Rot (For), Tomato Yellow Leaf Curl (TYLCV) and Verticillium Wilt (Va).
