Features

- Large-fruited pumpkin with minimal ribbing
- High yielding, approx. 6.5kg range
- Dark orange flesh and smooth grey skin
- Small seed cavity.

Description

GREYSTONE is a large-fruited, grey-skinned pumpkin in the Sampson/King Grey class. It has been shown to provide the grower with high yields of fruit in the 6.5kg range with a smooth grey skin colour with minimal ribbing. Flesh colour is a good dark orange with a small seed cavity.

This variety has the advantage of very little pink skin discolouration under periods of storage. GREYSTONE is a variety that sets fruit close to the crown and along the runners and can be planted at a little higher density than fully vining grey varieties, further increasing the yield potential.
