Description

INFINITE GOLD is a rockmelon in the Harper style and has been bred for flavour, fruit quality and extended shelf life with a strong disease package of Powdery Mildew (Px) and Fusarium (Fom). The variety has shown very good tolerance to ground cracking in trials to date. The vigorous vine sets mostly on the crown with uniform fruit size and shape, and a high yield potential. The fruit have a round oval shape with dry cavity, excellent firmness and dark orange internal colour. The melons have a blue green background with attractive net cover. The fruit of INFINITE GOLD are large in size, mostly in the 6-9 range, when grown in the correct timeslot. Sugars can reach levels of 12-14°Bx at correct maturity under favourable conditions.
