REEMA is a single-fruited variety for plantings in autumn and winter, for cool season production. The fruit of REEMA is of excellent quality and uniformity, being mid ribbed and medium green in colour. REEMA has shown very good results in substrate and soil plantings to date with good yield and an average fruit length of 17cm. REEMA is a vigorous plant with dark green leaves and has resistances to Powdery Mildew (Px) and Downy Mildew (Pcu).
