Description

SAMARA is a large beef type for the loose pick market. SAMARA is a vigorous variety with a strong disease package and has shown excellent setting and yield in Sydney plantings in both spring and autumn. SAMARA has a reliable setting ability throughout the plant, with very good uniformity on the truss. The large fruit average 170-180g in size with flat round shape and uniform green shoulder, with good colour at red. SAMARA has resistances to Fusarium Wilt (Fol), Nematode (N), Leaf Mould (Pf) and Tomato Spotted Wilt Virus (TSWV).

Cultural Notes: Not recommended for outdoor production.
