Cultural Notes: Butt fruit can get too large during cool periods in some areas as maturity times lengthen - smaller options like Merlot may be considered for use under these conditions. SARINA is more suited to outdoor use or covered production in soil, as it may get too large under hi-tech production. Merlot is suggested as a smaller fruit option under these conditions.
