STELLA's medium thick leaf is very lightly frilled and serrated, and goes from a triple red to a light green down to the fine stem attachment. STELLA has an upright growth habit, and produces a good yield of uniform and glossy, 3D curled leaves to give volume and colour for mixed bags. STELLA is suitable for year-round production with good Downy Mildew (BI) resistance, and has shown good tipburn tolerance in plantings to date.
